



## Leather Rough

Exclusive and soft aniline leather with a matt finish and natural milling grain which offers great seating comfort. Its thickness, visible insect bites, scars and other natural marks contribute to the exclusive appearance of this leather. These marks are a natural part of the leather and are not grounds for complaint. The grain side varies considerably across the same hide, which means there will also be considerable variations in the grain of the leather on a cover. This is not an accepted cause for complaint either.

Technical specifications: Chrome tanned and produced without the use of PCP and CFC which are damaging to the environment.

Complies with all recommendations from Dansk Møbelkontrol, the Danish Furnituremakers' Quality Control organisation.

Thickness: 1,1 - 1,3 mm

Colour fastness to light:  $\geq 3$  - EN ISO 105-B02

Bending durability: 20.000 - EN ISO 5402

Colour fastness to rubbing wet: 20 rubbings =  $\geq 3$  - EN ISO 11640

Colour fastness to rubbing dry: 50 rubbings =  $\geq 3$  - EN ISO 11640

Fastness to perspiration: 20 rubbings =  $\geq 3$  - EN ISO 11640
